- Much shorter induction than previous years.

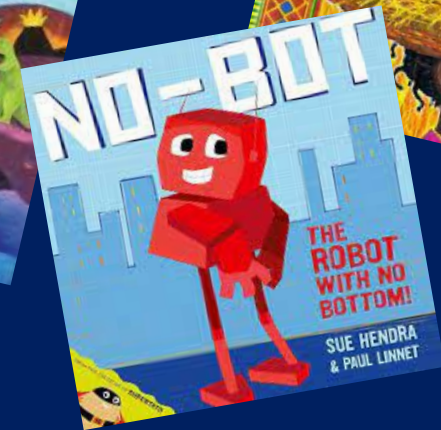
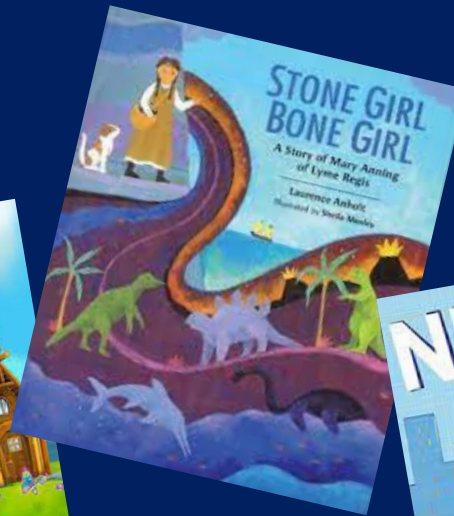
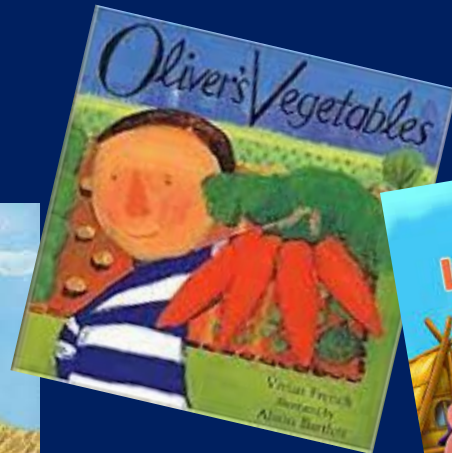
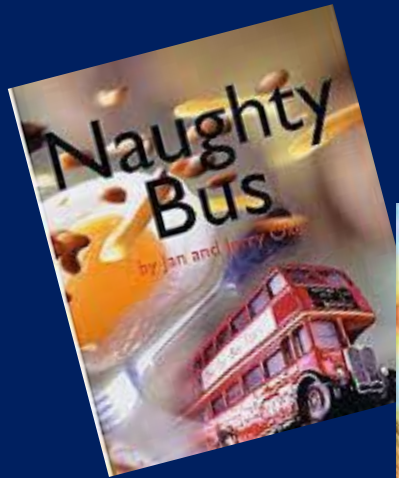
# What does a day in Reception look like?

# Phonics and Literacy

- Phonics – Read Write Inc – Government backed scheme, now rolled out across all schools in the Futura Learning Partnership.

- Literacy – rich variety of texts and genres used to engage the children and hook them in.



# How do the children learn?

At Chandag we learn in a variety of ways:

- Carpet time
- Group work
- Adult-led activities
- Choosing Learning

# What will the children learn?

- **Maths** – every morning for 20-30 minutes – we follow the White Rose scheme of learning.
- **Literacy** – every morning for 20-30 minutes with a different book focus each week and different genre of writing.
- **PE** – weekly, children come to school in their kit that day.
- **Discreet subjects** – RE, PSHE, Music – all of which have schemes that we follow.
- **Art** – Artist of the Term.
- Subjects like History, Geography, Science are covered through the areas of **Understanding the World**.
- **Forest School** once every term.

# What is Choosing Learning?

Children follow their own interests – they choose what they would like to do.

This could be:

- construction
- role-play
- Drawing
- reading corner
- junk modelling
- outside – sand, water, den building, ball games, large construction, the stage, mud kitchen, diggers and stones

The adults will take the learning to the children through high quality interactions.

Our team are highly trained in this way of working.

Our end of year data is always well above National Average and always one of highest on the Trust.
